

## LEGAL ASPECTS OF IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGY FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT IN ROMANIA

**Abstract:** *Sustainable development is the desire to achieve a balance, a synthesis between the aspirations of the free-born citizen, the society on which it depends and by which it is defined and the context that allows self-realization.*

### • Introduction

On September 25/26, 2015, in New York, the UN Summit on Sustainable Development took place, to which Romania also took part. During this event, a document entitled Agenda 2030 for Sustainable Development (“Transformation of the world in which we live”) was adopted. The adoption of the 2030 Agenda is the culmination of a long process of dialogue and negotiations involving both government representatives and non-state actors and launched in June 2012 in Rio Summit + 20.

### • Material and method

The materials used to write this paper consist of normative acts and web pages. The use methods had the role of performing a systematic analysis of the information from the studied sources in order to elaborate the views and conclusions.

### • Results and discussions

Romania, as a party to the 25/ Summit/26.09.2015 has undertaken to introduce in national legislation a number of 17 objectives set out in the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

The national strategy for sustainable development of Romania 2030 was adopted by the Government on 09.11.2018 by GD no. 877/2018, which was later modified and completed by GD no. 754/2022. Both normative acts refer to the National Action Plan for the implementation of SNDDR 2030 (National Strategy for sustainable development of Romania). In elaboration of GD 754/2022, the provisions of art. 7 par. 2 of GD.379/2022, art. 108 of the Constitution and GEO 57/2019 on the Administrative Code.

### • Conclusions

Romania attaches great importance to the UN, an organization with universal vocals, which is the most extensive multilateral framework for addressing major global issues, including issues related to long-term development. The objectives of sustainable development represent, internally, for our country, a complementary tool for mobilization in the field of economic and social development.
