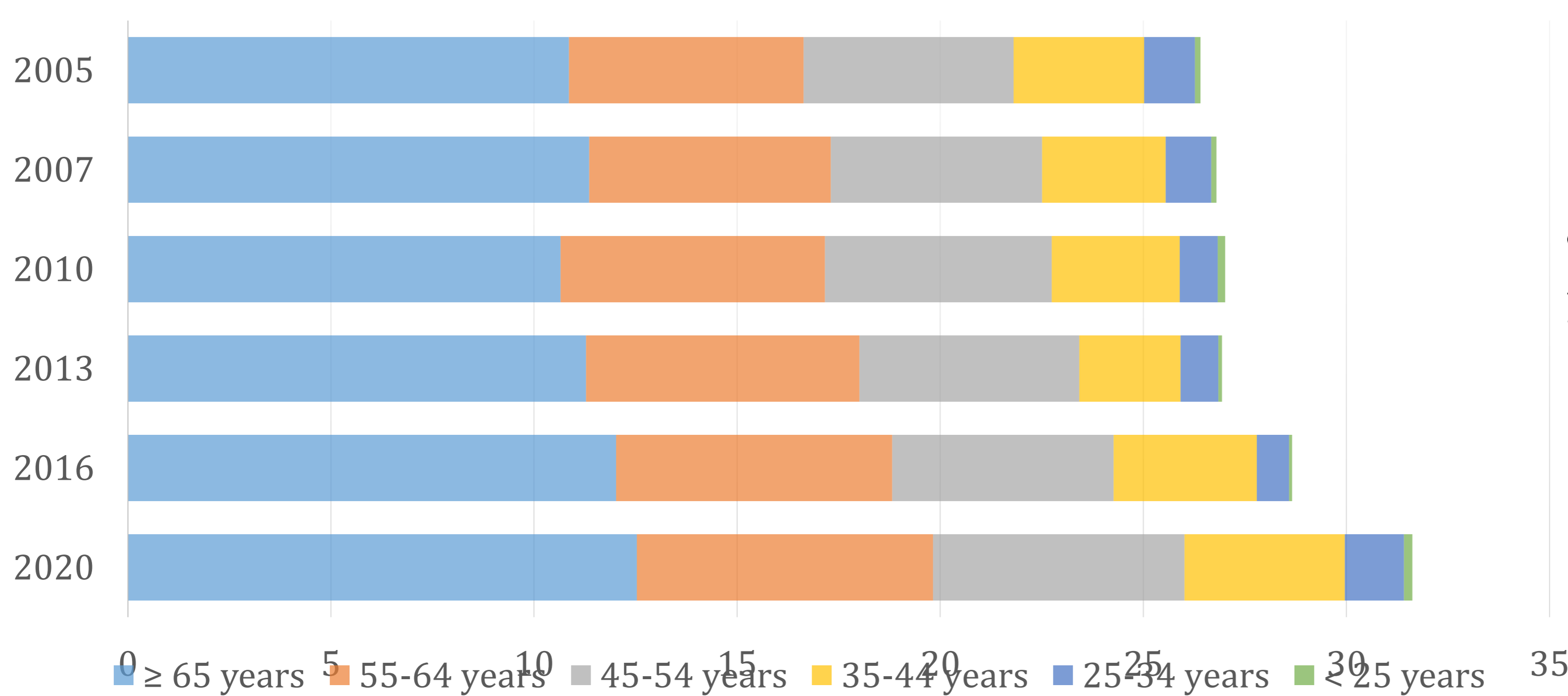




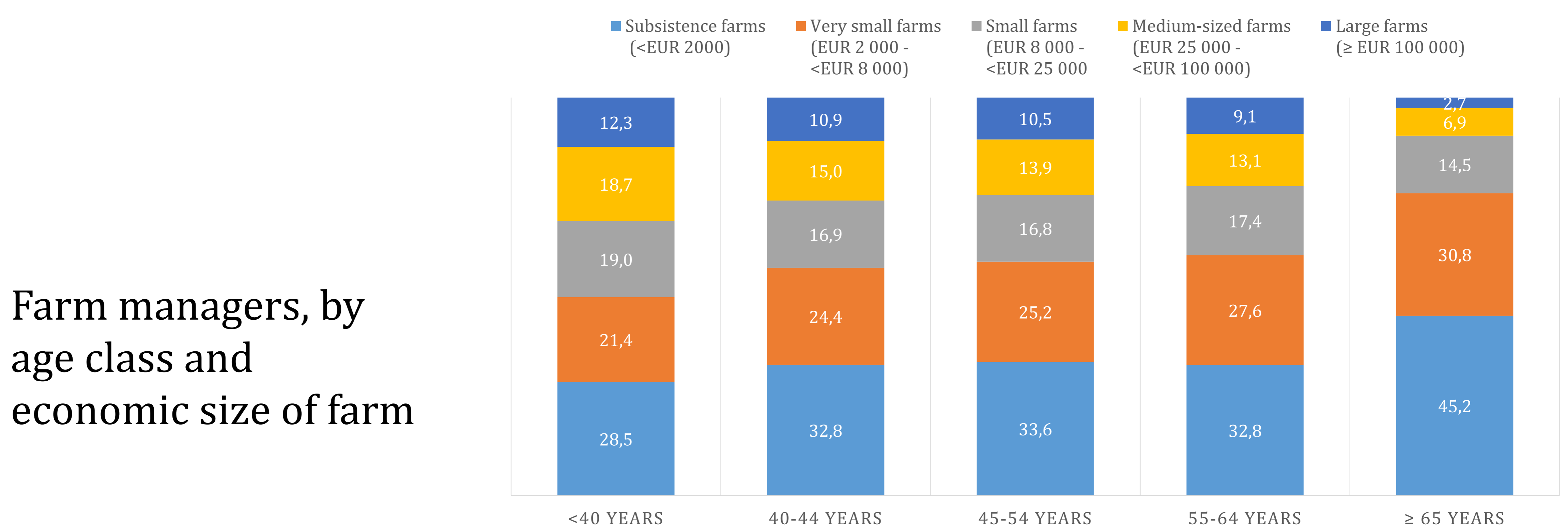
ASPECTS REGARDING FARM MANAGEMENT AND LABOUR FORCE- CASE STUDY
