
DO DIRECT PAYMENTS IMPACT ROMANIAN AGRICULTURE?

Abstract:

Direct payments play an important role in the financing of agricultural holdings in Romania. They represent the main form of support within the Common Agricultural Policy, financed by the European Agricultural Guarantee Fund. The purpose of this paper is to investigate the impact of direct payments on the economic situation of Romanian agriculture. Using linear regression functions, it was determined that direct payments affect positively and with a medium to strong intensity the value of agricultural production.

- ☐ Complementary income support for young farmers up to 40 years of age with agricultural skills.
- ☐ The estimated amount is around 50 euros per ha.
